Meetings shall be held in the City of North Miami Council Chambers on the Second Floor of City Hall, 776 N.E. 125th Street, North Miami, FL 33161. In accordance with the provisions of Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the CRA Board with regard to any matter considered at such meeting, that person will need a record of the proceedings. For such purposes, that person may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made. This record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

TRAFFIC WATCH

Here are some traffic problems expected this week:

NORTHEAST MIAMI-DADE

NORTHEAST 163RD STREET from First to 10th avenues

Eastbound and westbound lanes will be closed at various times during nonpeak hours, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., while workers resurface the road and perform other improvements. Sidewalks and curb ramps will also be closed temporarily at various locations.

NORTHWEST 12TH AVENUE from Seventh to 16th streets

All traffic has been shifted onto temporary travel lanes from Northwest Seventh Street to just north of the 12th Avenue Bridge. The contractor can close travel lanes during nonpeak daytime hours, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., to perform project-related work. At least one lane will remain open in each direction at all times and four lanes, two northbound and two southbound, will be open during morning and afternoon rush hours. The bascule drawbridge will continue to open on demand for marine traffic on the Miami River. Motorists anticipate delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible. Pedestrians and bicyclists should use caution and obey all "Sidewalk Closed" signs.

NORTHWEST FIFTH STREET BRIDGE at State Road 7

Contractors for the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Six, will begin removing the existing Fifth Street Bridge over the Miami River near downtown Miami. The bridge, which has been closed for several months, will remain closed, and established detours will remain in place. This work is expected to have little or no impact on street traffic; however, it might impact marine traffic intermittently. Project personnel will coordinate closely with the U.S. Coast Guard to minimize disruption. Construction of a new Fifth Street Bascule Bridge is currently scheduled to begin in late 2008, but this schedule is

tentative and might change.

WEST DIXIE HIGHWAY from Northeast 119th to 151st streets

Single-lane closures will occur on the outside lanes in each direction. Lane closures are from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays and weekends.

WEST DIXIE HIGHWAY at Northeast 10th Avenue

Access between West Dixie Highway and Northeast 10th Avenue at the intersection of Northeast 135th Street has been permanently closed.

NORTHWEST 12TH AVENUE BRIDGE and Northwest Eighth Terrace underpass

Northwest Eighth Terrace is closed to all vehicular and pedestrian traffic beneath the Northwest 12th Avenue Bridge. The underpass will remain closed for several months. Access to area businesses is available by taking Northwest Seventh Street to Northwest 11th Avenue, east of the bridge or to Northwest 12th Court west of the Bridge. Motorists are not able to go east or west under the bridge along Northwest Eighth Terrace.

NORTHEAST 191ST STREET at Biscayne Boulevard

One eastbound lane and one northbound lane will be closed for installation of new storm water drainage. The northbound lane closure on Biscayne will occur from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. One westbound lane on Northeast 191st Street will be closed for the duration of the six-week project.

NORTHEAST 167TH AND 163RD STREETS from Northwest First Avenue to Northeast 10th Avenue

Single outside travel lanes and sidewalk sections might be closed temporarily at various times and locations between Northwest First Avenue and Northeast 10th Avenue during nonpeak hours (9 a.m.-3:30 p.m. and 9 p.m.-5:30 a.m.) while workers perform roadway improvements in this area. Nightly paving operations might require closing one additional travel lane (two lanes total) between 9 p.m.
