Attention North Miami Voters!

The City of North Miami's Charter Review Board and the North Miami City Council Approved amendments to the City's Charter that can be found on the November 7th Ballot. These amendments are important for the future of North Miami. We urge our voters to be sure to vote and to make sure that you read through the entire ballot.

North Miami - Amendment 1

The Charter currently contains specific density and height limitations that conflict with other contemplated and existing documents in the City including the proposed Comprehensive Plan. It is proposed that such limitations be modified to provide for total conformance to the City's Comprehensive Plan.

North Miami Charter Amendment 2

The city charter requires that the city obtain voter approval at an election before city property, with an appraised value greater than \$25,000, is sold. It is proposed that the city have the ability to sell property without the need for an election provided it cannot sell the property for less than 90% of the appraised value of the property.
