

**Supplement Number 1 to North Miami CRA RFQ/P 2007-9 Revised**  
**Response to Questions Submitted dated December 11, 2007**

Question(s):

- (1) On Page 3 in the Proposal Instructions, Item #2b states: “Proof of authorization pursuant to State law as a construction manager providing architectural and engineering services including submission of copies of all pertinent State issued licenses.” This statement gives the impression that you are looking for an Architect/Engineer who is a Construction Manager. However, a Construction Manager/Owner’s Representative has the construction experience in totality, but is not a registered Architect or Engineer. Please clarify.
  
- (2) I have a question in reference to section 2., line b. of the RFP: Can the submitting firm be a stand-alone Owner’s Rep firm, or must we be teamed with a licensed A/E?

Response:

The CRA desires to make clear that the intent is not to require a qualified, stand-alone Construction Manager/Owner’s Representative to team with an Architect or Engineer in order to respond to the RFQ/P. Therefore, statement 2.b. in the RFQ/P is hereby modified to read as follows with the changes indicated in bold print:

“b. Proof of authorization pursuant to State law as a construction manager providing **as may be applicable** architectural and/or engineering services including submission of copies of all pertinent State issued licenses.”
